Who should Attend

Concrete Contractors interested in learning how to place and finish pervious concrete.
Ready mix producers interested in gaining field experience and learning technical aspects about pervious concrete.

About the Program

The program is designed to teach concrete contractors and producers about the specifications and technical aspects of pervious concrete paving. **“A Storm Water Management System”**. The first part of the training session will be classroom training. Participants will cover, in detail, the KRMCA Pervious Concrete Specifications, pervious concrete placement finishing techniques and commonly asked questions and answers about pervious concrete. The classroom session will be followed by a 30-question exam with questions taken from the study guide. This session will be followed by a “hands on” training session in the afternoon where participants will actually place pervious concrete. Participants who pass the classroom (minimum of 70% on the written exam) and hands on training will receive a certificate from the KRMCA stating they have successfully completed the course.
